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SOAP POCKET

Needle: #8 circular needle
Yarn: 50% acrylic 50% cotton or
100% cotton yarn
2 skeins of yarn

Pocket:

Using two strands of yarn held together;
CO 24 sts
P until piece measures 4"
Next row: (P2tog, YO, P1) repeat to end
Next 2 rows: P all sts; then BO
Fold piece wrong-side out and stitch bot-
tom and side, then flip piece right-side out.

Cord:

CO 2 sts
K2 sts then slide to other end of ndl, pull
yarn tight around behind and repeat.
Continue until I-cord is 12" long
Thread cord through holes so that the
beginning and end of cord are on the
same side of the pocket (see photo above)



WASHCLOTH

Needle: #8 straight or circular needle(s)
Yarn: 100% cotton yarn

Washcloth: small (medium)

CO 28 (44) sts
Rows 1-6: P all sts
Row 7: P3, *K1, P1* repeat between * until
last 3 sts, P3
Repeat Row 7 until washcloth is desired
size (be sure to K the P rows and P the K
rows to create seed stitch)
Last 6 rows: P all sts
BO

This washcloth can be machine washed
but will keep its shape and size better if
you do not put in the dryer. If you find the
washcloth stretches with use, putting it into
the dryer on high heat for a few minutes
can help bring it back to its original size
